

THIS INDENTURE made this 14 day of March 1890.
witnesseth that GEORGE J. LADUE of the Town of Hyde
Park, County of Dutchess, State of New York, now aged 17 years,
by and with consent of GEORGE F. LADUE his father residing
HYDE PARK
in ~~the~~ aforesaid hereon endorsed,
hath voluntarily and of his own free will and accord, put and bound
himself apprentice to the Poughkeepsie Glass Works of the City of
Poughkeepsie, in the state of New York, to learn the art, trade and
mystery of a Hollow Glass Ware Blower, and as an apprentice to
serve for the period of five years from the 14 day of
March 1890 during all which time said apprentice his
Master and its officers and duly appointed Foreman and Foremen,
faithfully, honestly and industriously shall serve, its and their
secrets keep, and all lawful commands everywhere readily obey; at
all times protect and preserve the goods and property of said Mas-
ters, and not suffer or allow any to go to waste or be injured.

He shall not absent himself from his Masters service dur-
ing so much of said time as the works of the said Poughkeepsie
Glass Works shall be in blast, or in fire, without leave, and shall
behave himself in all things during all said time as a faithful
Apprentice ought to do.

If he should absent himself from duty during the five
years at such time as the Works are in operation, without having
first obtained consent from the Superintendent or Foreman in
charge, he shall make good to the Poughkeepsie Glass Works for
such lost time, and the termination of his Apprenticeship to be
extended to a date when such lost time shall have been made up to
the entire satisfaction of said Poughkeepsie Glass Works.

And the said Poughkeepsie Glass Works by its managing officers, Foreman and proper Overseer, shall use and employ its utmost endeavor to teach or cause him, the said apprentice, to be taught or instructed in the above trade, giving him during said term and opportunity of perfecting himself in the art or mystery of a Hollow Glass Ware Blower in all its various departments, so far as the same may be conducted by it.

AND THE SAID POUGHKEEPSIE GLASS WORKS AGREE to pay to said Apprentice, or if they prefer, to pay to his said father for him, for such ware as he shall make during the period aforesaid, one-half the amount paid to expert and competent Blowers from time to time for the same kind and class of ware by said Poughkeepsie Glass Works, less the sum of twenty-five (25) per cent of said one-half; which said percentage shall be retained until the same shall amount to the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, and thereafter the whole of said one-half price shall be paid.

Said payments shall be made at such times, and in such manner as shall be the practice of paying Blowers at said Poughkeepsie Glass Works Factory.

And should said Apprentice have faithfully served his full time, and deported himself at all times as a good and honest Apprentice ought to do, said Masters will pay within one month after the close of the Blast at which his term of Apprenticeship will expire, said sum of Two Hundred Dollars, or so much thereof as may have been retained to that time.

But in case said Apprentice shall not serve his full time faithfully and honestly, no part thereof shall be paid, and there shall be no claim therefor by or in behalf of said Apprentice, or any other person.

And for the true and faithful performance of all and singular the covenants and agreements aforesaid, the said parties

bind themselves each unto the other firmly by these presents.


